SCHOLARSHIP AWARD APPLICATION

C.U.P.E. Local 593 (Mission Support Staff of School District #75) offers scholarship monies up to \$1000 to be awarded to a graduating student(s) whose parent/guardian is a Support Staff Employee of the Mission School District. This scholarship is available to graduates inside and outside the Mission School District. The C.U.P.E. Scholarship Committee will select the recipient(s) from the applications received. The name(s) of the successful candidate(s) will be announced at the Graduation Ceremonies in June 2023.

This scholarship is available to students who are planning to further their education at any post secondary institution. This includes University, College, Business, Trades, Beautician, Tourism, Aviation, etc. Funds will be forwarded upon proof of tuition paid to the educational institution to which the incumbent has applied.

Note: High academic standing will not necessarily be the deciding criterion of the awarding of this scholarship.

C.U.P.E. Scholarship Criteria:

Applicants must be in Grade 12 in the school year in which they apply.

Applicants must enter an approved post-secondary institution within two years of the award, or the scholarship will be withdrawn.

Applicant must have a parent/guardian who is a Support Staff Employee of the Mission School District.

Application must include:

1. A **one page typed** autobiographical essay.
2. **One** academic reference letter (ie. teacher, counsellor, administrator).
3. **One** general reference letter from outside of the school system (ie. employer, coach, minister, neighbour, etc.)
4. **One** copy of your transcript of grades.
5. **Most recent** grade 12 report card.
