- 2. Are currently in Grades 7, 8, 9, 10 or 11;
- Must be continuing with Middle/ Secondary School Studies in the following school year.

HOW IT WORKS (Conditions of the Award)

- 1. Recipients must use the award in the following school year. (i.e. if you receive it April of 2024 it must be used during the 2024/2025 school year)
- 2. Must be registered as a full-time student in a Middle/Secondary School with Mission Public School District 75.

HOW SELECTION IS MADE: (Selection Process)

- 1. Siwal Si'wes Indigenous Education Advisory Council members, along with community and Mission Public School District representatives, review applications to make final selections.
- 2. Bursaries are based on community involvement, academic ability and student need.
- 3. Successful candidates will be notified of the amount of the award in a letter from the Chairs of the Siwal Si'wes Indigenous Education Advisory Council.

HOW TO APPLY

- ♦ Applications must be hand delivered to Siwal Si'wes or post-marked by 4:00 p.m., Thursday, February 22, 2024.
- ♦ Applications must include copies of Term 1 and 2 Report Cards.
- ♦ Applications must include a current Transcript of Marks
- ♦ Applications must include a copy of the attendance record (from September 2023 onwards)
- Applications must include a one-page (minimum 250 word) essay describing:
 -the applicant's future goals and reasons why he/she should be selected.
 -information about applicant's Indigenous ancestry
 -involvement in cultural and Indigenous community activities,
 -the plans to use the award.
- Applications must include: *One letter of recommendation from a teacher who knows the applicant well. Must be a teacher, and it cannot be a family member.
- ♦ Applications must include name, address, phone number and school of applicant.
